Juliana was a talented martial artist, fierce competitor, accomplished academic student and a loving, honest and loyal friend. PROGRAM GUIDELINES – SUBMISSIONS DUE June 30th, 2024

The Juliana Buongiovanni Memorial Scholarship will be awarded annually to the high school student(s) and/or current college student(s) who best meet the requirements set forth by the Scholarship Committee.

- Scholarship awards are limited to cover tuition and fees.
- Scholarships are open to high school students and students currently enrolled at an accredited college or university.
- The Scholarship Committee will review and score all submitted applications.
- At the Scholarship Committee's discretion applicants may be interviewed.
- Award amounts will be determined by the Scholarship Committee.
- Scholarship recipients will be notified of award via email.



APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

Qualified applicants must meet ALL of the following criteria:

- be a current taekwondo academy member in good standing.
 - **“Good standing”** is defined as a member who regularly attends class, is committed to mental and physical discipline and whose behavior is demonstrative of effort towards achievement of the five aims of taekwondo: Respect, Humility, Perseverance, Self-control and Honesty;
- be a black belt (any level);
- have participated in at least one competitive event during the last twelve (12) months;
- have an unweighted Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 2.75 on a 4.0 scale and;
- plan to attend, have been accepted into or currently enrolled at an accredited college or university on a full-time basis.

INSTRUCTIONS – READ CAREFULLY

- The application form can be found on the Y.H. Park Taekwondo Academy website <http://yhpark.com/>.
- **All questions must be answered. Incomplete applications will not be considered.** If the applicant believes a question is not applicable, do not leave the response blank. Write “N/A” in the space provided.
- Attach additional sheets as needed to complete application questions. Label all additional sheets with your name and the question number.
- Application packets will ONLY be considered complete IF the following items are included and submitted on or before the June 30th, 2024 deadline.
 - Completed Application form
 - Essay and Creative Project
 - Three (3) references with contact information (on application form)
 - A copy of your most recent high school and/or college transcript
 - Letter of “Good Standing” from your Master on the school’s letterhead.



- Proof of the applicant having competed in at least one competitive event during the last twelve (12) months. Verification from the applicant's Master is acceptable in either an email or letter.
- Two (2) letters of recommendation (from persons other than relatives). A "Letter of Recommendation Form" is provided at the end of this Application.

WRITTEN ESSAY and CREATIVE PROJECT

WRITTEN ESSAY

In 750 words or less, write about an obstacle you encountered and describe in detail how taekwondo helped you to overcome it.

Your essay should be free from spelling and grammatical errors and be formatted as follows:

1. Typewritten, double-spaced, single-side printing on standard white 8.5" x 11"
2. Applicant's name should be placed in the upper right corner on each page
3. All pages should be numbered
4. If multiple pages, staple in the upper left corner

Applicants should include three (3) hard copies with the completed application packet. If submitting by email, please send the essay as a PDF document using the following file naming convention:

"Applicant First Initial.Last Name_Taekwondo School Name_Year_Scholarship Essay"
